

SEVEN LAWS OF THE LEARNER	
1. The Law of the Learner	Teachers are responsible to cause students to learn.
2. The Law of Expectation	Expect the best from your students
3. The Law of Application	The purpose of content is lifechange.
4. The Law of Retention	The art of how to teach the student the most information in the shortest time with the least effort and the greatest retention. Use signs, posters, charts, pictures, music, rhymes, alliteration, color, activities, discussion.
5. The Law of Need	If your class isn't motivated, perhaps the reason is that you did not have the right worm on the hook. Seize attention. Stir Curiosity. Stimulate felt need. Surface real need. Satisfy real need.
6. The Law of Equipping	Equipping is best evaluated by what the student does after class and should impact both character and conduct.
7. The Law of Revival	Teaching impacts is directed to the emotions and the will.
