1. When you think about God wanting to be your partner in His redemptive plan, how does that affect your attitude toward giving?
2. If you haven’t tithed in the past it can seem daunting to start. For many, it’s hard enough living on their current income and they can’t imagine living on less. What advice can you give to someone who wants to begin tithing to God? Are there steps they can take to begin giving or to increase their current giving?
