Psalm 16:11 • John 15:11 • Romans 14:17 • Hebrews 1:9

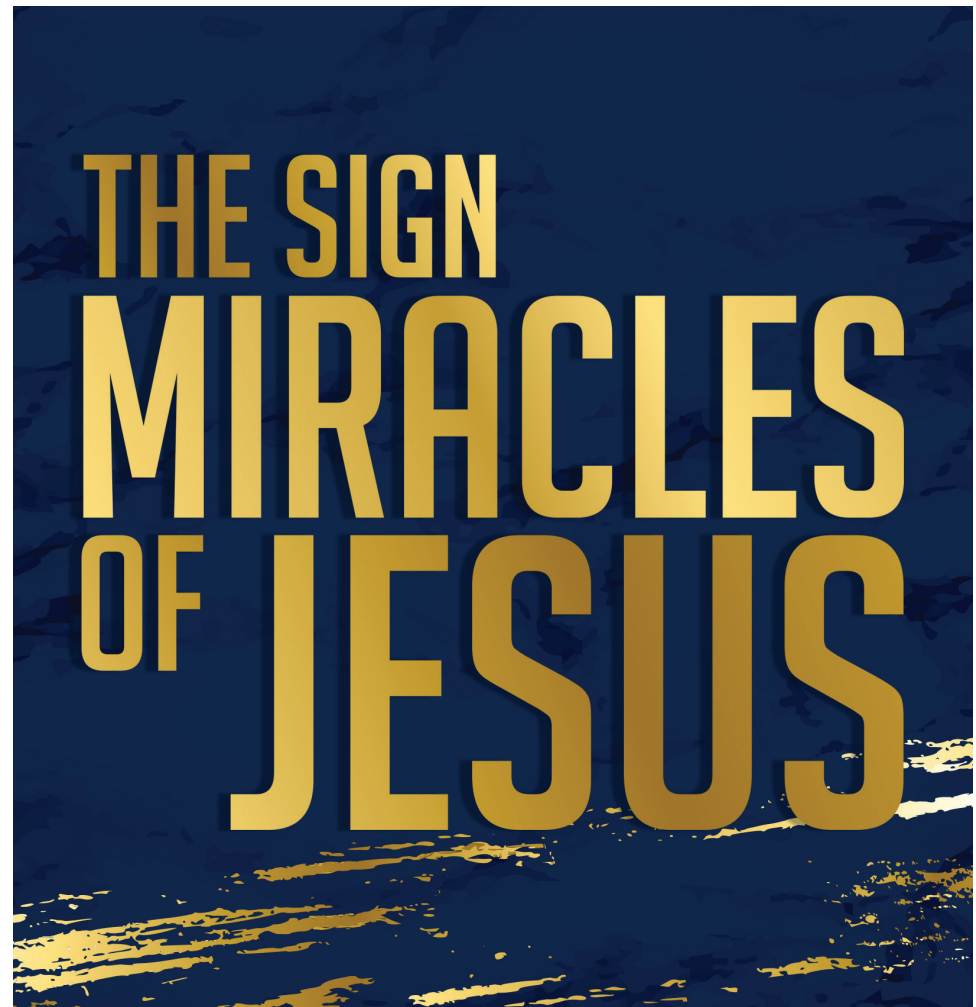
5. Read 2 Corinthians 5:17. On your Christian journey, when has your life felt new?
