Describing the Purpose - John 6:33, 35

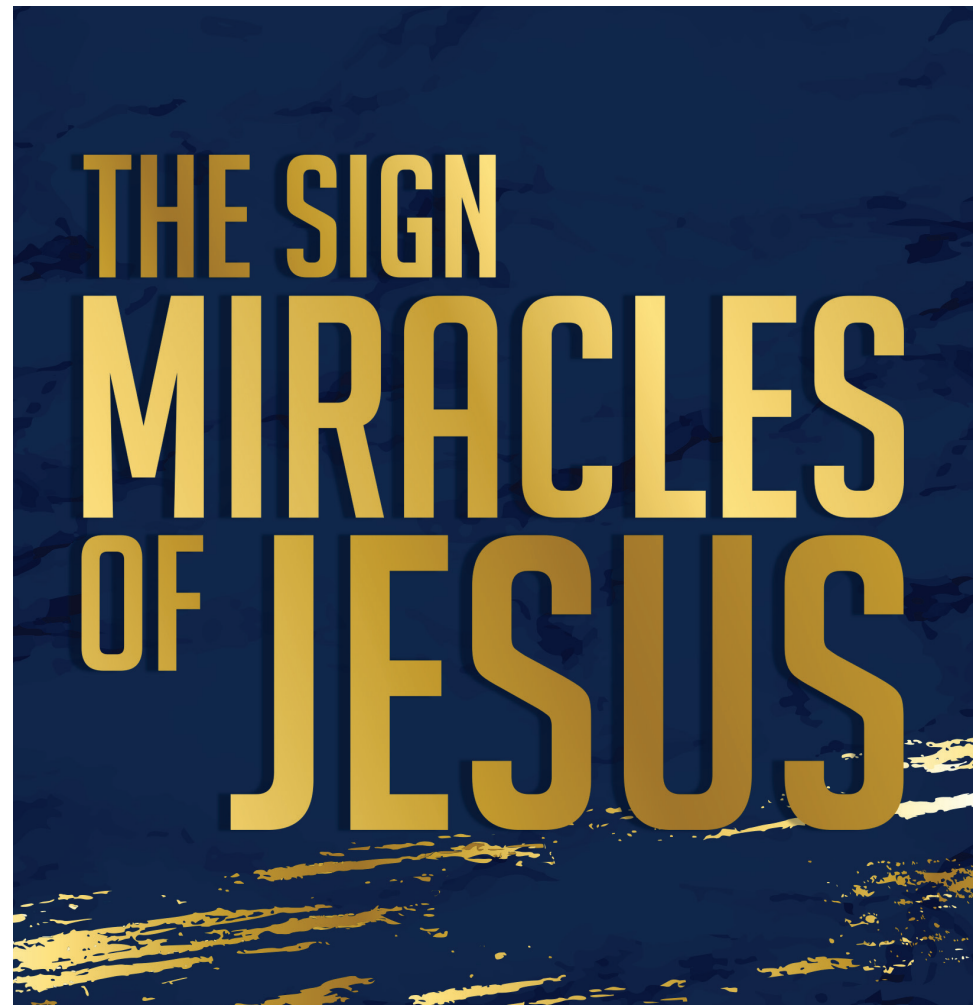
4. We also heard, "When you dedicate what you have to God and place it in His hands, He can multiply it." When have you seen this happen in the life of someone you know?
