2. Describe a time for the group when you felt as though you had limited or no vision and what it felt like in that moment. How did you resolve it?

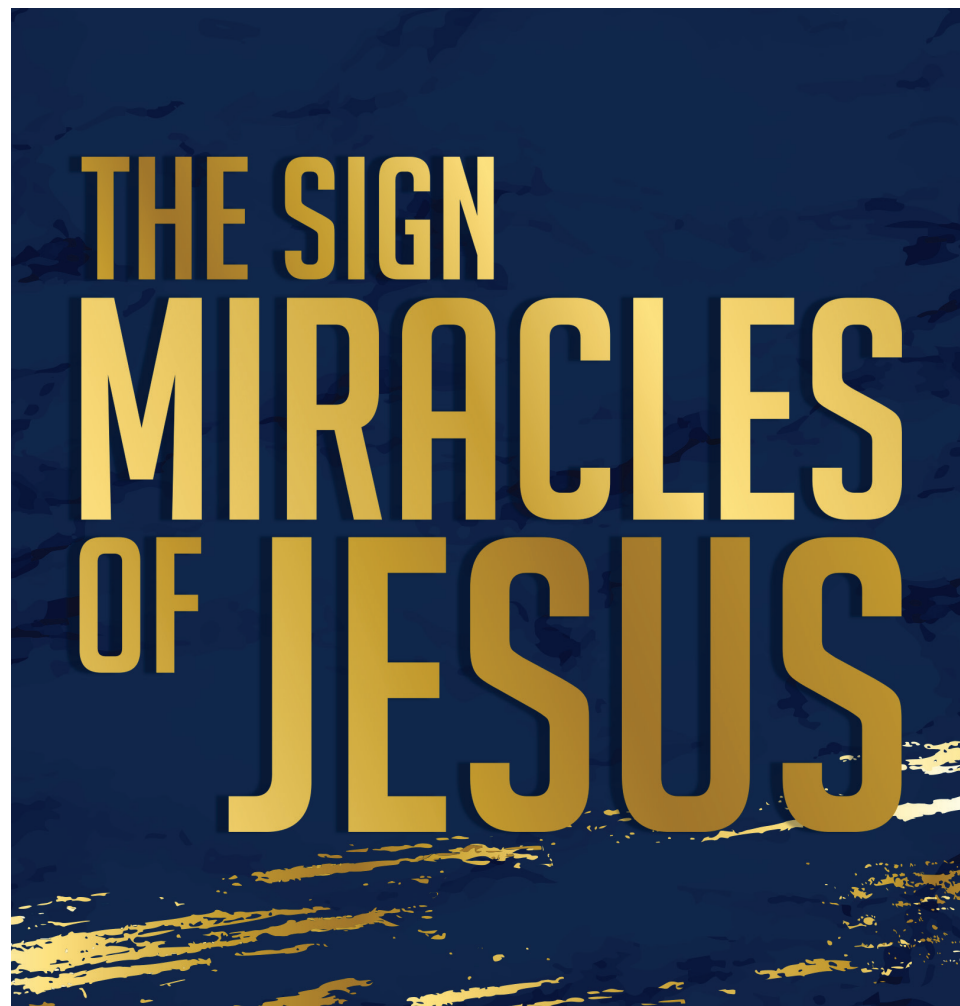
Digging Deeper

3. Read John 9:6 says. How does this healing show us the methodologies God uses to open the eyes of the spiritually blind?
4. In what ways are we blinded in our ability to help those who need it? In light of Matt 9:36, 14:14, & 15:32, how are we to respond to those in need?
5. According to this weekend's message, what are the three ways in which God is glorified by sickness? Or, looking at it another way, what are the three ways God demonstrates His works through those who are suffering? Read Psalm 119:67.
