1. Read the last three words in 2 Kings 5:1. When have you felt that the good parts of your life were outweighed by one negative issue?
2. Read 2 Kings 5:7 and 1 Peter 5:6-7. Look back at Getting Started #2. What were your dominant thoughts and feelings during this time?
3. Read the following verses and describe why the Bible teaches that humility is a better option than pride.
Psalm 73:6 Proverbs 11:2, 16:18 & 19, 22:4, 29:23
Matthew 18:4 1 John 2:16
4. Read 2 Kings 5:2-3 and 1 Peter 3:15. We heard, “Powerless and insignificant, [the young girl] was full of faith and expectation about her God.” What can we learn from this young slave girl and her willingness to share what she knows with Naaman?
5. Read 2 Kings 5:11-12. Why do you think Naaman was so upset? Why did Elisha’s command make Naaman so angry?

Bringing it Home

1. Humility means we let God lead us in His way, not ours. How is God leading you right now that feels uncomfortable, unwanted, and difficult?
2. Read Romans 8:28. How might you be resisting God because you don’t feel you can trust Him? How can you accept this season of challenge as a gift from God?
